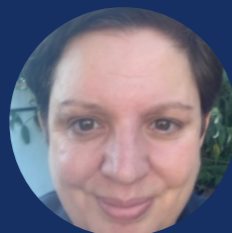
Zuhre Omar's incredible efforts to provide families with food parcels and other support must also not be forgotten.
