CAMPUS UPDATE

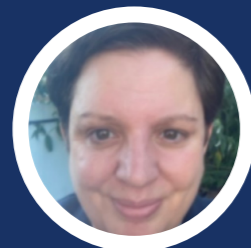
This term, we launched our lunchtime enrichment programme which features a range of exciting new clubs including those for games, dance, sewing and our newly formed Chickenshed Choir!
