Safeguarding

Evidence shows that the key danger times for young people in relation to becoming involved in anti-social behaviour and becoming victims of robbery and other forms of youth violence are on weekdays between 3pm and 6pm.

Suggested strategies for keeping your child safe:

- Remind your child to come straight home after school unless involved in after school clubs or other organised activities.
- Check in with your child if they are not home by the normal time.
- If your child asks to go to a friend's house, contact the parent to check the arrangements.
- Configure location settings on your child's phone so you are able to track their location.
- Make plans with your child for 'unknown' situations where they may get into difficulty e.g. what to do if the bus breaks down.
- And finally, discuss any concerns you have with a member of the Safeguarding team at school who will be able to offer guidance and support.
