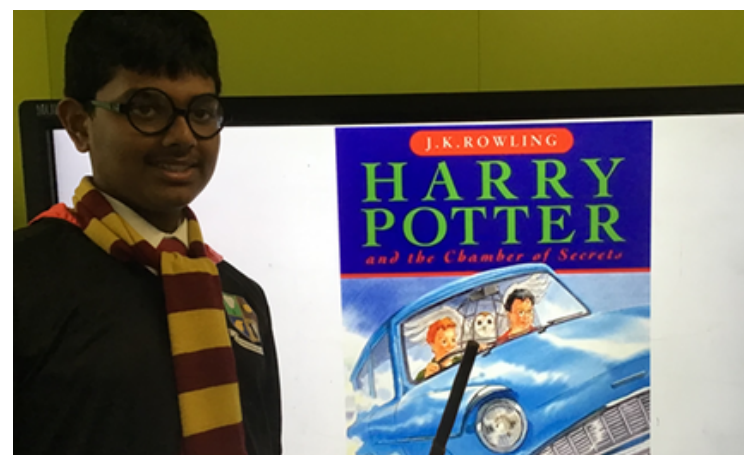


Our Middle Leader Rebecca Gardner did a fantastic job organising many exciting reading prospects across National Storytelling Week.
